

Strippy Scrap Jacket

Calling all fat-quarter collectors - or anyone with a great collection of small scraps! This box-style jacket is fitted through the shoulder area, but full through the lower back to provide ease of movement. The straight sides are perfect for colorful strips and with the addition of shoulder pads (optional) you can turn an everyday jacket into a great-fitting jacket with a tailored look. You choose your colors, embellishments and finished style. Jacket is lined (optional) and detailed instructions are included for attaching shoulder pads.



Yardage Requirements

You have a choice of 2 methods for constructing the strips for this jacket: the strip method and individual pieced method. Yardage requirements are provided for either - you choose the method you prefer. Best color-combination results will be achieved with at least 12 different prints.

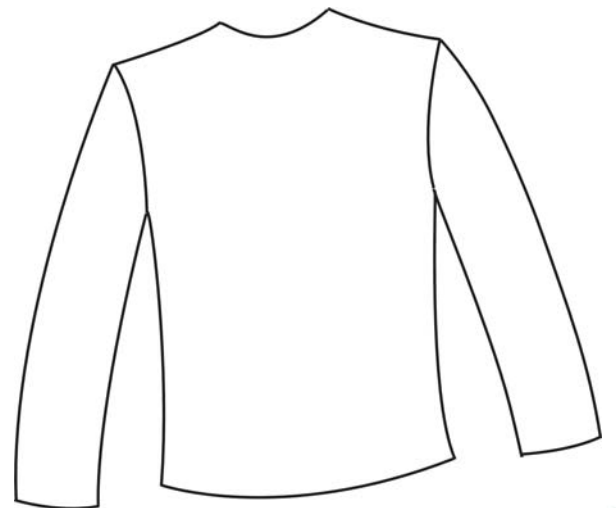
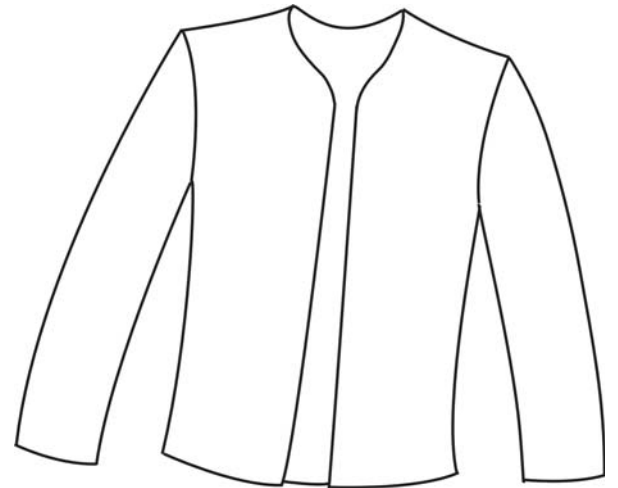
