

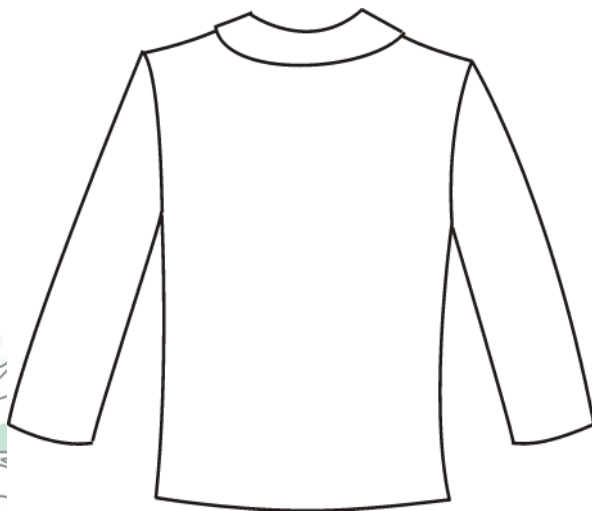
The Quarter Circle Jacket

This great jacket is designed with no shoulder pads and has a little extra ease across the back for comfort. There is also an optional front pocket. The quarter circle quilt blocks can be arranged in an endless variety of designs and we have included the layout for the jacket on the cover. We suggest that the background be one fabric so the circles can take center stage. Purchase fabric for the circles or create from your personal stash.
