

Shirt Club Pattern

Rio Blanco Topper

Create a long and lean look with this easy-to-make shirt/topper.

Waist insert curves upward around the body adding to the long look and the finger-tip length completes the style. Set-in sleeves, front and back darts and an easy flat contrast insert add to the total image. This pattern is easy to intermediate.

Design options give method for lining if you prefer a jacket.

Shirt Club Patterns are designed so you can mix and match. Any shirt/blouse bodies will easily interchange with any of the sleeves.
