Pattern

Another beautiful basic for your collection, this V-Neck blouse has Bishop Sleeves gathered to a French Cuff. The collar is designed so you can make the double collar version, or use the lower collar for a single-collar version as well. Although very nice in cotton prints, this blouse is especially nice made in Cotton Batiste, Cotton Voile, Handkerchief Linen or other lightweight material.

What is a Shirt Club Pattern?

Shirt Club Patterns are designed so you can mix and match. Any shirt/blouse bodies will easily interchange with any of the sleeves. See website for Cross-Reference Chart and details

BONUS

If you prefer a traditional cuff, this sleeve will fit the standard 1-button cuff from the Basic Long Sleeve Shirt Pattern. Likewise, this French Cuff will fit the Basic Long Sleeve 'sleeve' pattern.
